## Abbie's Baptism



This month our sweet Abbie girl made the choice to publicly declare her faith through baptism ([see video clip and read Abbie's testimony on our blog](#))! Our international church meets in a hotel, so our church family headed up to the rooftop pool for her baptism. It was such a joy to see Abbie declare that her family's faith is her personal faith!

Rachel made Abbie a "Baptism Memory Book" which include's Abbie's testimony, pictures from her baptism, and small notes of encouragement from Abbie's family and friends. ## James Children's Bible Study

Over the past few months Rachel wrote a children's Bible study on the book of James! The James study contains 34 lessons for older children (ages 7-13). Each family devotional lesson takes around 10 minutes and walks through the entire book of James.

Rachel followed the ARTS acronym:

A - Ask a hook question to draw the kids into the lesson.

R - Read the passage.

T - Think about the passage by asking the kids questions.

S - Self-reflect on how the passage applies to your life.



Children who will benefit from this study most are 2nd-8th graders who are able to easily read and understand a Bible passage. Younger children can learn from it too, but it's definitely geared for older elementary or middle school kids. Rachel was able to share this Bible study with several families in Chiang Mai and their families are benefiting from doing this study with their children.

Please check it out and consider using this with your older kids during your family devotional times too! It's been a great experience for our kids, and we are continuing this method of Bible study for family devotions and are now studying the book of Ecclesiastes (at the kids request - "It's Daddy's

favorite book and we want to know more about it."). It's been a good experience for seminary professor dad to take the book down to the kid's level.

We hope this James Children's Bible Study will be a blessing to some of your families too!
