This month our family spent two weeks in the town of Mae Sot - which is about 5 hours southwest of Chiang Mai on the border of Myanmar (Burma). Greg taught an ABTS Wisdom Literature class and the majority of the students were Karen refugees residing at the Mae La refugee camp. Greg also had the privilege to preach at the refugee church on Ecclesiastes as he shared about living wisely even in difficult times. We also had the privilege to bless the refugees with food! Due to your generosity we were able to give them \$850 worth of rice, fish, garlic, onions, apples, and more. Alwyn, the head of the Bible

college at the refugee camp, came with us so we knew what would be best to get. The kids were excited to surprise the 100 refugee children living at the Bible college with pocky (chocolate covered pretzel sticks). Greg also took his students out for dinner the final night of classes - a treat many refugees have never experienced before. Thank you for praying for our ministry to these sweet believers!
