Disability Ministry



This month God gave us the opportunity to participate in two new ministries to people affected by disability. First, we took some of our youth group teens to throw a harvest party for some special needs children at a local foster home (click the play button above to see a short video). Each teen helped their buddy do a craft, frost a cookie, and play games. Abbie formed a special connection with one of the little girls and plans to go back to visit her every month. Greg had his little buddy giggling amidst balloons, bubbles, and tag. The staff thanked us for days afterwards for giving these sweet children such a special afternoon.

Second, we were both asked to be the adult speakers at the first ever [Joni & Friends International Family Retreat](#) for overseas workers affected by disabilities. For many years Joni & Friends has done retreats throughout the world for families who have a family member with a disability, but this was the first retreat for missionary families serving overseas who have a family member with a disability. Greg shared encouraging words from Ecclesiastes about dealing with disability in our broken world, and Rachel shared her testimony and explained how disability can be an asset in ministry. It was such a joy to be able to connect with these special families who are serving overseas with the additional challenge of having children with disabilities.

Youth Group Retreat



This month we led our first international youth group retreat! We had 40 teens attend and it was amazing to spend several days connecting with them through the preaching of God's Word, worship, and just being together swimming and playing games. Greg led worship, and we both had the opportunity to share our testimonies. The teens grew in their relationships with God and we were blessed to connect with them on a deeper level too. They are already asking us when the next retreat will be and if it can be longer next time!
