


Dangerous Air Pollution

It's "pollution season" in Chiang Mai right now, meaning the local farmers are burning their crops to clear their fields and our valley nestled in between the mountains is trapping all the harmful air pollutants. Our outside air is dangerous to breathe. We have 7 air filters cleaning the air in our home and air filter mesh on our air conditioners to keep the air in our home reasonably clean. When we go out we have to



wear masks with air filters in them to protect our lungs. Our eyes often burn and feel irritated (think getting a puff of smoke in your face while around a campfire), and we usually wake up to headaches and sore throats. It's a challenging time in our little tropical part of the world, but we serve a God who's faithful through every season – even pollution season. 
Kids Club Outreach
