Smoky Season



It's smoky season in Thailand meaning the air is unhealthy to breathe while the farmers are burning their fields in order to clear them for the next planting seasoning. In order for air to be healthy to breathe the AQI (Air Quality Index) should be under 50 and somedays we're about 400. Many days when we go outside we can smell the "campfire" smell. We wear pollution filtering masks when outside, but really we should all have on full face gas masks to filter this level of pollution.

Abbie is just getting over bronchitis. Isaac is on antibiotics for a cough, and Hannah is on antibiotics for a double ear infection brought on by nasal congestion. All of this is a result of this smoggy air. We spend most of our time indoors in with air purifiers on because it's hazardous to go outside right now. It's truly heart breaking to see the many Thai families that can't afford air purifiers and pollution filtering masks. They experience health issues even more severe than us and at the same time don't have access to good medical care. Please be praying for our family's health and for the AQI to improve.

This month Greg passed his PhD dissertation defense! He's now Dr. Greg Vruggink, which is a huge accomplishment as he's now completed all the requirements needed to be a long term professor with Asia Biblical Theological Seminary! We're so grateful to God for helping Greg persevere over

We're rejoicing that after antihistamines, adrenaline, and steroids he fully recovered!



Homeschool Ministry



This month Rachel has been busy putting together the final pieces for the fall 2023 semester of the Chiang Mai Homeschool Co-op which serves 140 children and 50 families who are living internationally and homeschooling their children. Each Monday there are 3 extracurricular classes (academic, artistic, and athletic) for each age group. It's a lot of work putting together the schedule, emails, class details, and teachers needed to make this happen, but Rachel loves being part of this ministry that is truly life giving to so many families on the mission field and is also a huge opportunity to share the gospel with non-believing homeschool families.

Rachel's also been finishing up the 4 Vruggink kids' homeschool year. Their final day is April 7. We'll

then have two high school students with Christian being in 11th grade and Abbie in 9th grade. This fall Isaac will be entering 5th grade and Hannah 3rd grade.
