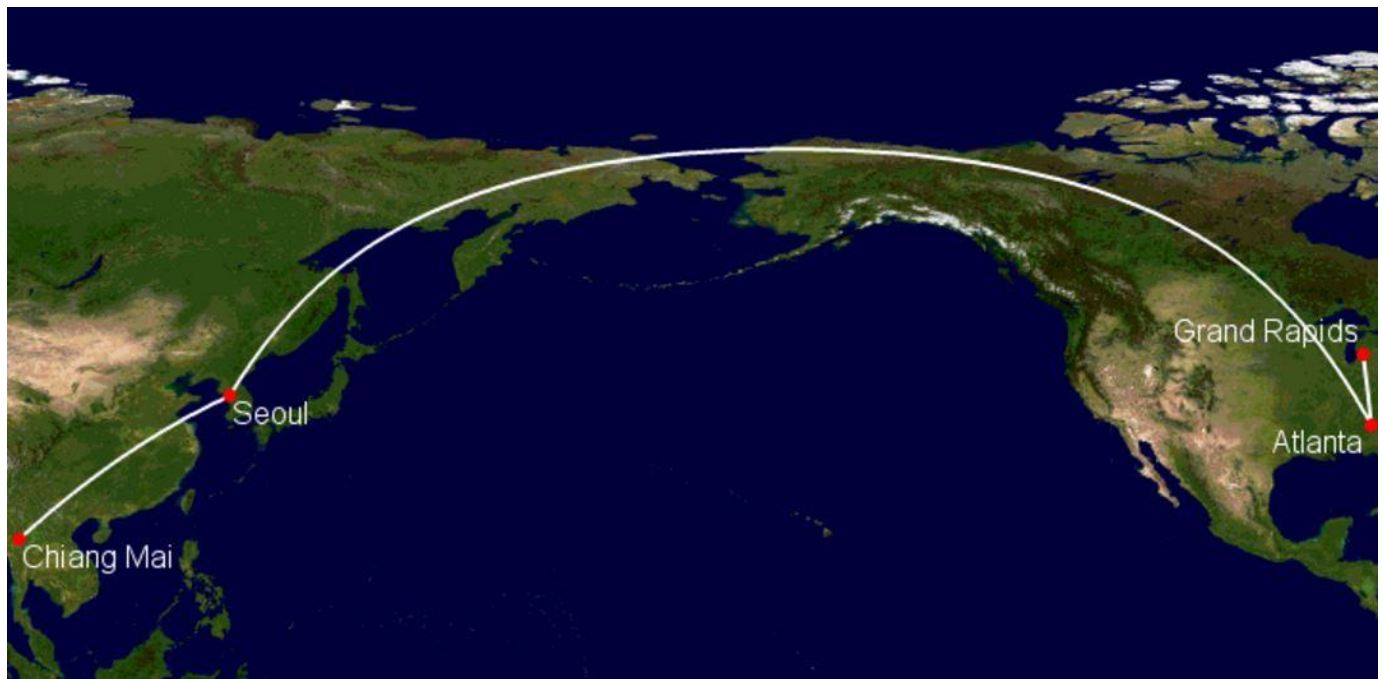

Leaving for Thailand!



In exactly one week our family will begin our journey to Thailand! We'll be traveling on Delta airlines from Grand Rapids, Michigan to Atlanta, Georgia to Seoul, Korea to Chiang Mai, Thailand - a 26 hour total trip!

On Tuesday, August 8 we will be entering the Grand Rapids airport with 17 suitcases/action packers, 2 car seats, 2 wheelchairs, 3 guitars, 3 carry on bags, 2 adults, 4 kids, and a partridge in a pear tree! Please pray that none of our luggage, car seats, wheelchairs, or guitars will get damaged or lost during transport. Also, please pray that our little ones especially will handle the traveling well, and will get good sleep on the 15 hour flight from Atlanta to Seoul, Korea. Abbie and Isaac are really nervous about flying (they've never been on an airplane before), so please pray for God to give our children His perfect peace as we travel.

Please pray we'll be able to find a permanent home to rent quickly as this apartment is 4-stories up with no elevator so it's not ideal long term.

Once we are settled into a home, the seminary will remain the very best address to send cards and packages because letters and boxes sent to an office tend to arrive a little more reliably than to a home address. 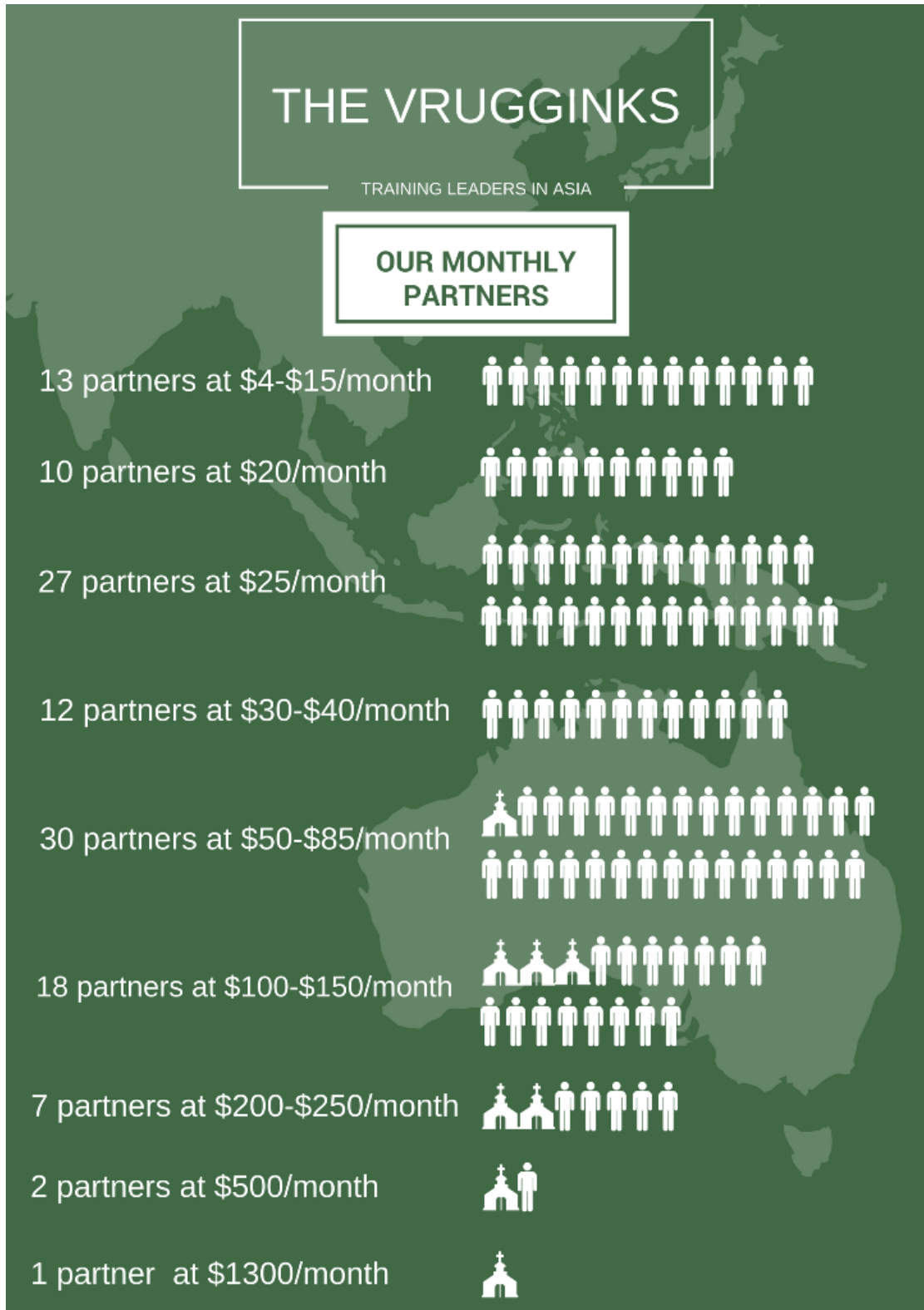
#1 Prayer Request
