Three ER Runs

This month we had to make three trips to our Chiang Mai emergency room!

ER Trip - #1



Earlier this month our sweet Abbie girl was taken to the ER with a severe headache and a terrible facial rash that we had been unsuccessfully able to treat with Benadryl and Zyrtec. She was prescribed a topical steroid cream, but for a week the rash continued spreading down her neck and onto her upper back and chest. For several weeks she had almost no energy, headaches, and was sleeping around 20 hours a day. Thankfully through the prayers of many people after a week Abbie's body began to heal and the rash started to clear. After another two weeks her itchiness was gone and her energy returned. However, sadly yesterday the rash returned. We're working with a pediatric allergist to clear the current rash and on March 15 Abbie will have a skin test done. Please pray for Abbie's current rash to heal and for us to discover the cause of the facial rashes.

ER Trip - #2

After Greg returned from his trip some precious lifelong friends came to visit us. While they were with us, there was a stairs incident resulting in a severely sprained ankle and our second ER run. Thankfully we had a spare wheelchair and our home is accessible as we had two mamas in wheelchairs taking care of their families. Despite the fall we had a wonderful time with our friends.

And for our third ER run, our little Isaac injured his left big toe, almost ripping off the nail, and unfortunately his toe got infected so into the ER he went this past Tuesday. The surgeon removed the toenail, and Isaac is now on antibiotics and his toe is healing.

Although we've spent more time in the hospitals that we would prefer this month, we are thankful for the good medical care we have been able to receive in Thailand! Please pray that God will protect our family in the coming months and provide us with good health.

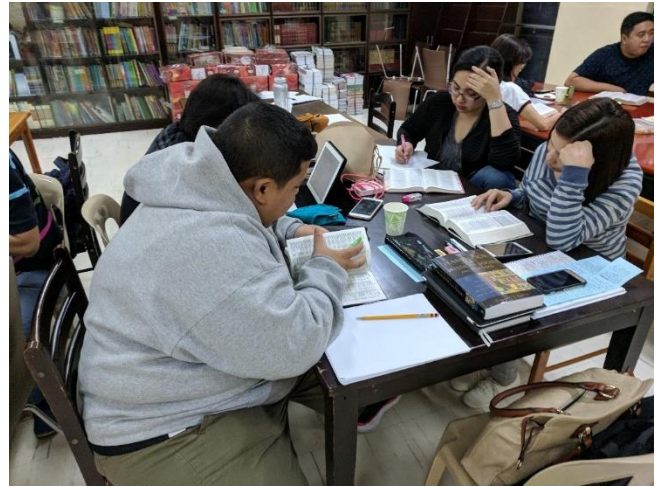

We know that there is hope, but sometimes knowing that there is a book of the Bible that

speaks so deeply of the brokenness of the world can be a different kind of comfort.

In addition to lectures, there was a lot of group work and practice teaching from the wisdom books. There was even a visit one evening from the ABTS board, who were having their meeting in Manila (see the top picture above of the board with the class). Overall, it was a great time of learning and growing in God's Word!
